US Defense Secretary supports TPP, Vietnam manufacturing base, Shrimp Anti-dumping

U.S. Defense Secretary supports TPP and TPA

Secretary of Defense Ash Carter jumped into the debate over trade, arguing approval of fast-track Trade Promotion Authority and the proposed Trans-Pacific Partnership agreement would bolster U.S. security ties in the fast-growing Asia region. He also stressed the benefits of the proposed trade deal to U.S. businesses and entrepreneurs. "There are already more than 525 million middle-class consumers in Asia, and we expect there to be 3.2 billion in the region by 2030," he said.



Vietnam loses appeal in WTO shrimp dispute with U.S.

The World Trade Organization's Appellate Body on Apr 7 ejected all of Vietnam's appeals in its challenge of the U.S. Commerce Department's decision to maintain anti-dumping duties on Vietnamese shrimp in three departmental reviews of an existing duty order. This means that the earlier ruling by a dispute settlement panel stands in its entirety, including the points on which it ruled against the United States, which the U.S. did not appeal.


We are going to invest US\$100 million in building a Gillette shave care plant in VSIP II. The plant will provide jobs for approximately 300 people, and one of the only three Gillette manufacturing plants in Asia. Vietnamese technicians and engineers are being sent to the U.S., Germany and Poland for technology training. Products from the new plant will serve both Vietnamese and Asian consumers.



Japanese printer makers turn Vietnam into manufacturing base

Fuji Xerox is planning to turn its plant in Hai Phong into a production hub which will serve the Asia Pacific region. The plant, which cost \$120 million, is now able to produce two million units per year and currently employs 1,600 people. Fuji Xerox's president Tadahito Yamamoto cited the approaching ASEAN Economic Community and Trans-Pacific Partnership as contributing to the firm's decision to expand the plant. Canon and Kyocera also have significant operations in Vietnam.

The Emerging Middle Class in Developing Countries



Growth of both multinationals and the global economy will depend increasingly on emerging market consumers, especially in Asia (ASEAN, India, and China). They are spending more on basic necessities like homes and food, but also extras such as meat, mobile phones, and air conditioners. Global middle-class spending should rise from \$21.3 trillion in 2009 to \$55.7 trillion in 2030. Asia's share should increase from 23% in 2009 to 59% in 2030.

News and Issues Updates



Asian Development Outlook 2015 - Vietnam Summary

Rising FDI helped accelerate Vietnam's GDP growth to 6.0% in 2014. Inflation abated, and robust external accounts enabled the rebuilding of foreign reserves. Growth is forecast to edge higher again in 2015 and 2016, while inflation remains relatively low. Policy challenges are to reform banks and state enterprises and to integrate domestic firms into global value chains.



International arrivals down 23.4%, ... but visa fees up?

This was the sharpest fall in many years. "Tourist numbers are down so they increase the visa price to compensate ...?" said one commentator, who added that the policy change "only results in even fewer tourists," and suggested that Vietnam "lower the fees, give more countrie visa exemption to attract more tourists."



Uber gets conditional approval in HCM City

The Government of Vietnam has approved a proposal by the Ministry of Transport to create favorable conditions Uber but assign different agencies to monitor it to guarantee healthy competition. Ministry inspectors will undertake snap checks on Uber and failure to comply will be fined. The ministry has also asked the Ministry of Finance to oversee Uber in terms of tax matters, the Ministry of Industry and Trade to monitor e-commerce, the State Bank of Vietnam to inspect card payments by the Uber app and the HCMC government to see whether Uber observes its investment certificate. This week, Uber launched in its 300th city, Amman, in its 56th country, Jordan. The 6-year-old company's value? An estimated \$40 billion.

P&G to invest \$100 million in new Gillette razor factory in Binh Duong



Procter & Gamble (P&G) Viet Nam announced an investment of US\$100 million to build a Gillette razor plant in Vietnam Singapore Industrial Park II, in Binh Duong Province, in a ceremony to celebrate its 20th anniversary in the country. P&G was among the first U.S. companies to enter Viet Nam after the Viet Nam - US normalization of relations. It has become one of the top fast-moving consumer goods (FMCG) companies in the country.



Representative Sander Levin, leader of the Democrats, on TPP

In Levin's 32 years in Congress, he has voted in favor of 14 trade pacts and opposed four - defying then-President Clinton to vote against the North American Free Trade Agreement. How he will vote this time remains unknown to the White House, and maybe even to him. "It's all about trying to shape a trade agreement so you understand the impact on people, their livelihoods," Levin said.



House of Representatives Minority Leader visit to Vietnam Mar 30-Apr 1

Minority Leader Nancy Pelosi, the leader of the Democrats in the House of Representatives, visited Vietnam Mar 30 - Apr 1 accompanied by nine other Members. The California Democrat has essentially endorsed the approach advocated by House Ways & Means Committee Ranking Member Sander Levin, who has argued that lawmakers should focus their attention now on ensuring the administration gets the details of TPP right before approving TPA, or 'fast track,' which would allow the White House to submit a trade deal to Congress for straight up-or down votes without any amendments. Businesses protest plan to curb import of used machinery with revised Circular 20

"To be honest, a 20-year-old machine made in Sweden is better than a brand new one produced in China." Businesses are reluctant to buy Chinese machines even if they are new since the quality cannot be compared with those made in Europe, Japan or the US 10 years earlier. Nguyen Van Dong, chairman of Vietnam Printing Association, called the ban "unreasonable," "impractical" and "baseless," arguing that machines used in different sectors have different life expectancies. The proposed circular would only help Chinese companies dominate the market by forcing small and medium businesses to buy cheap machinery from the neighboring country.



Vinatex to build textile and apparel raw materials complex - for TPP

Spread over 20ha in Que Son District, the VND1.14 trillion (US\$53.5 million) project wi include a fibre factory that will produce 4,600 tonnes of products per year, a textile and dyeing factory with a 5,000-tonne annual capacity, and Huong An garment factory with 20 knitwea production lines, which will produce 20 to 25 million products per year. Vinatex will also build a factory that will treat 5,000cu.m of wastewater per day to serve the production needs at the complex.



HCM City's Metro Line #1 picks up pace for completion

Construction on Ho Chi Minh City's Metro Line #1 has been accelerated with the anticipated completion date brought forward to 2019, and with the first trains to begin running by 2020. Duong Huu Hoa, deputy director of the Project Management Unit Metro Line 1 under the Ho Chi Minh City Management Authority for Urban Railways (MAUR) said, "we are speeding up the implementation of package 2 which covers the line along the Hanoi Highway. So far, we have completed more than half of the main construction work."

Gov't pushes for reforms to improve business environment



The Prime Minister will focus on improving the business environment and strengthening the economy's ability to compete in 2015 and 2016. Key areas of Government Resolution 19/2015 released Mar 12 include pushing for reforms to reduce time-consuming and wasteful administrative procedures, enhancing governmental offices' transparency and accountability, and adopting regulations that are in accordance with international commitments and standards.
