#### Agriculture minister explains new regulations to US firms

Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development Nguyen Xuan Cuong explained several new regulations regarding agriculture during a working session with Michael Michalak, senior vice president of the US-ASEAN Business Council.

At the session in Hà Nội, a representative from the US's Cargill Corporation expressed concerns that the ban of the use of several kinds of antibiotics for growth stimulation in animal husbandry as specified in Circular 06/2016/TB-BNNPTNT is likely to hinder growth of the sector.

The First APEC Senior Officials Meeting (SOM1) entered its second working day in the south central province of Khanh Hoa's Nha Trang city on March 3 with a series of issues high on the agenda, including food security and climate change.

An agreement to enhance trade linkages and foster sustainable, inclusive and innovative growth marked a positive wrap-up to the first Senior Officials' Meeting (SOM 1) and other related APEC meetings on Friday.



#### New transfer pricing decree: a step closer to international standards

On February 24, 2017, the Vietnamese government released the new transfer pricing (TP) Decree No. 20/2017/ND-CP 'Providing tax administration applicable to enterprises having controlled transactions' (Decree 20), which will take effect from May 1, 2017.

Decree 20 replaces the existing TP regulations (Circular No.66/2010/TT-BTC) and provides new compliance requirements in Vietnam.

While Decree 20 is loosely based on Circular 66, it extends the interpretation of existing provisions and introduces additional concepts and principles from the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) Guidelines and Base Erosion and Profit Shifting (BEPS) Framework.



#### Dong Nai revokes 40 delayed, abandoned FDI projects

The Industrial Zone Management Board of southern Dong Nai Province has revoked investment permits granted to 40 FDI projects that have been abandoned or delayed for a long time.

According to Mai Van Nhon, deputy head of the board, the revoked projects have total investment of over US\$300 million.



## White House split on import tax puts Congress in limbo

A major split among senior White House officials over whether to effectively create a new tax on imported goods has stalled the broader tax overhaul effort on Capitol Hill, with Republicans looking to the Trump administration for leadership on an issue that has drawn fierce resistance, according to several officials with direct knowledge of the matter.



## New policies take effect in March

A string of new policies on certificates of land use rights, casino business activities for Vietnamese residents, horse and greyhound racing and international football betting, and government guarantee come into force in March.

## News and Issues



### TÜV Rheinland's EMC Laboratory Accredited by Vietnam's Ministry of Science and Technology to Test Household Appliances

TÜV Rheinland's Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC) Laboratory in Thang Long Industrial Park II, in Hung Yen Province, has been accredited according to ISO 17025 by Vietnam's Ministry of Science and Technology to test household appliances, information technology equipment (ITE), industrial equipment, scientific equipment and medical devices. It has also been recognized by the Directorate for Standards, Metrology and Quality (STAMEQ) as an EMC testing laboratory for CR mark certification of household appliances.



### Japanese Emperor's visit to boost rapport

The first ever visit to Vietnam by a Japanese Emperor and Empress was a historical event of great significance that will reinforce mutual trust and friendship, said a senior Japanese official. Speaking to the Vietnam News Agency (VNA) ahead of the historic visit, Hatsuhisa Takashima, press secretary to Emperor Akihito, recalled the long-standing relationship between the two countries.



### Trump, Abe meet to discuss bilateral Free Trade Agreement

along the lines of Senate Finance Committee Chairman Hatch's recommendation. Senator Hatch said the Trans-Pacific Partnership can be ratified under President Trump even if it begins as a bilateral deal with Japan, emphasizing that his plan would be in accord with Trump's pledge to pursue fair, bilateral trade deals instead of larger regional ones.



### Vegetable, fruit exports to struggle

The domestic vegetable and fruit industry will face obstacles in maintaining sustainable growth in export value at the current high level, according to the Việt Nam Vegetable and Fruit Association. Total national export value of vegetables and fruits reached US\$2.4 billion in 2016, a year-on-year increase of 30 per cent. Export value is expected to increase to \$3 billion this year.



## HCM City and Hanoi lead e-business index

HCM City and Hanoi continue to lead Vietnamese localities in e-commerce, The Việt Nam E-commerce Association (Vecom) announced at the 2017 Việt Nam Online Business Forum in Hà Nội on Friday.

The announcement came from the 2016 e-Business Index (EBI), based on a survey from more than 3,500 businesses in 54 provinces and cities across the country.



## ANZ paints rosy outlook for VN economy

Viet Nam is likely to have something to crow about during the Year of the Rooster as several factors will facilitate socio-economic growth, ANZ Vietnam said on Friday.

In a press briefing titled "What lies ahead in the Year of the Rooster?" experts from the Vietnamese branch of the Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Ltd. outlined their views of the global and regional economy, as well as a detailed outlook for Viet Nam in 2017.



## Vietnamese SMEs take advantage of online business trend to enhance competitiveness

E-commerce with multi-channel selling has become a popular method in the world which helps small and medium enterprises (SMEs) optimize their operations.

"Online retail in Vietnam will continue to accelerate in the upcoming period as domestic and foreign retailers now move towards multichannel with considerable investment in online retail," said Nguyen Ngoc Dung, vice president of the Vietnam E-commerce Association (VECOM) at the Vietnam Online Business Forum 2017 (VOBF) in Hanoi today.



## Foreign investors show interest, will Vietjet's shares fly high?

Vietnamese budget airline Vietjet Air will start trading 300 million shares on the Ho Chi Minh City Stock Exchange (HoSE) on February 28 at VND90,000 (\$3.9) per share.

As Vietnam's largest private airline nears its landmark initial public offering, foreign investors contemplate buying the remaining 25 per cent of the 49 per cent foreign ownership limit. As previously reported by VIR, only 24.39 per cent of foreign ownership has been reached as of January 12.



## WhatsApp's New Feature Continues Facebook's Snapchat Mimicry

Facebook offered \$3 billion to buy the ephemeral messaging app Snapchat in 2013. Snapchat's founder, Evan Spiegel, turned down the offer.

Ever since, Facebook and some of its top apps - including Instagram, WhatsApp and Messenger - have been trying to tap into the explosively popular photo-sharing features pioneered by Snapchat.



## 2011-16: VN gains almost \$60b in footwear export

Viet Nam's export value for leather and footwear gained stable growth every year during the 2011-16 period to reach US\$57.5 billion in total.

Under statistics from the General Department of Customs, export value reached \$6.5 billion in 2011, \$7.3 billion in 2012, \$8.4 billion in 2013, \$10.3 billion in 2014, \$12 billion in 2015 and \$13 billion in 2016.



## APEC links key to tackle disasters, says official

Regional connectivity should be strengthened to devise more initiatives to cope with the "new norm of natural disasters" facing APEC members, a Vietnamese official said yesterday.

During the 11th meeting of APEC's Emergency Preparedness Working Group (EPWG) in Nha Trang, Khánh Hòa Province, Water Resources Deputy Director Trần Quang Hoài briefed participants about natural disasters in Việt Nam, which have becomes increasingly frequent and severe recently.



## Triple-E container ship docks at Cai Mep international terminal

Margrethe Maersk, a Triple-E container ship which is the world's largest, docked at Cai Mep International Terminal (CMIT) on Monday - a milestone in Vietnam's navigation history. With the arrival of Margrethe Maersk, CMIT, located downstream Cai Mep River of the southern province of Ba Ria-Vung Tau, is the first port in Vietnam and the 19th in the world to be able to handle an 18,300-TEU Triple-E vessel, according to the Sai Gon Giai phong (Liberated Saigon) daily.

## Deputy PM out to aid local retailers

Deputy Prime Minister Trinh Dinh Dung has asked ministries and authorities to help support local retailers while better managing the operations of foreign retail firms.

The wholesale and retail market is developing rapidly with large potential and attracting the attention of both local and foreign investors, according to a recent note from the Government Office.



## Food safety need practical measures

Practical and specific measures are needed instead of general and vague directions from authorities to ensure clean production and food safety.

The statement was made by National Assembly Vice Chairman Phung Quoc Hien during a meeting held by the 14th National Assembly Inspection Committee with the Ministry of Health (MoH), Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD), and the Ministry of Industry and Trade (MoIT) on the implementation of food safety policies and law from 2011 to 2016.



## Vietnam among the most vulnerable to cyber threats

Viet Nam was named the nation facing the second-highest level of cyber security risk in Asia Pacific markets by a Microsoft Asia report on Thursday.

The Asian branch of the American computer giant released regional findings from the Security Intelligence Report (SIR), Volume 21, a twice-yearly report that provides unique insights into the threat landscape to help organisations learn about trend data in industry vulnerabilities, exploits, malware and web-based attacks.



## Infrastructure boosts Dong Nai property market

The property market is booming in the southern province of Dong Nai of thanks to its excellent infrastructure.

The local Department of Construction said 250 property projects were developed recently, 15 by foreign investors and involving a minimum investment of US\$10 million.



## 2017 expected to be better for investment funds

Investment funds are expected to perform better this year, following the successful 2016, on expectations that more individual investors will purchase their own investments, reported Đầu tư Chứng khoán (Securities Investment) newspaper. Two factors that will make investment funds attractive to individual investors this year include the trading of some 1,500 companies in the securities market, which will bring investment opportunities to individual investors.



## Vietnam to boost ties with US: Ambassador

Vietnam attaches importance to promoting relations with the new administration and Congress of the US, towards further developing the Vietnam-US comprehensive partnership in a practical, effective, stable and long-term manner, the Vietnamese ambassador to the US said. Ambassador Pham Quang Vinh made the statement at a reception in Washington DC on February 10 for more

than 70 advisors and assistants of key offices and committees of the US Congress of the 115th tenure.




## Enterprises see opportunities in 2017

Trần Văn Mỹ, general director of Phong Điện Scavi Company, said that his company is building an industrial centre specialising in textile and garment at the Phong Điện Industrial Park Hué City. The first hub of its kind in Việt Nam was in fact run on a trial basis in 2015 and 2016. Mỹ said the facility is due to be put into operation in the second quarter of this year, bringing together various segments involved in textile production such as feedstock, fabric accessories, design, fashion illustration and finally production of large volumes of finished products for exports.



## January 2017 FDI higher year-on-year

Foreign direct investment (FDI) into Viet Nam reached US\$1.42 billion from the beginning of the year until January 20, according to data from the General Statistic Office. The amount exceeded FDI during the same period in 2016 by 6.6 per cent. During this time, Viet Nam attracted 175 newly-approved projects with total registered capital up to \$1.24 billion, up by 37.8 per cent in terms of project number and 23 per cent in terms of capital compared with the same period last year.



## MoST & MoIT agree to science and technology cooperation

The Ministry of Science and Technology (MoST) and the Ministry of Industry and Trade (MoIT) have signed a cooperative program on science and technology coordination between the two ministries in the 2017-2020 period.

Recognizing its important role, the industry and trade sector has already applied science and technology to its industrialization, modernization and sustainable development efforts.



## PwC: Vietnam is set among star performers

By 2050, six of the seven largest economies in the world could be emerging markets. This is according to the latest report from the PwC economists on the theme of the World in 2050: The long view: how will the global economic order change by 2050?

Vietnam could be the world's fastest growing large economy in 2050, rising to 20th in the global GDP rankings by that date, the report stated.



## Environmental protection tax hike hurts firms

The Finance Ministry (MoF)'s proposal to almost triple the environmental protection tax on oil and gas consumption would reduce businesses' competitiveness against foreign firms, according to the Việt Nam Chamber of Commerce and Industry (VCCI). VCCI sent their comments on draft amendments and supplements to the environmental protection law to the ministry expressing concerns on the proposed tax hike.



## The case for renewable energy

With innovations making renewable energies more affordable than ever, it forces the question - are old technologies like coal actually cost-effective when you correct for all factors? Policy change, reforms, and public education could open the doors to the private investment needed to make the change to sustainable energy sources. John Rockhold, head of the Vietnam Business Forum's Power and Energy Working Group and executive director of ABBO Investment Consultancy & Engineering JSC, shared his opinion on the country's future energy plans.



## Vietnam to grant e-visas to citizens of 40 countries

beginning Feb 1, 2017. According to Decree 07/2017-NĐ-CP, 25 Jan 2017, procedures for applying and payment will be done online. It will take 3 days to process applications for an e-visa valid for 30 days. The visa does not require letters of guarantee or invitation. This could substantially boost international visitors and FDI. The regular one-year validity, multiple-entry visas will continue to be available to U.S. Citizens.



## Traceability programs improve food safety in HCM City

HCMC vice chairman Le Thanh Liem asserts that the traceability program for pork and vegetables is of paramount importance to ensure that local consumers can have clean foods, especially during the upcoming Lunar New Year when the food demand surges. Liem added that the program is not just about pork and vegetables, but other products in modern shopping



## Air Quality Index provides daily updates

amid growing concerns that air pollution in Hanoi has been worsening and reached dangerous levels. Hanoi's air has been repeatedly ranked as "unhealthy" and at times "hazardous," which means everyone should avoid being outdoors



## Sustainable Seafood

Nationally prominent chefs, fishermen, academics, and activists call on consumers to choose local species of fish when possible to protect the long-term vitality of harvested seafood and the well-being of the oceans. Some key numbers: 70 to 80% of global fish populations are not sustainably fished. 90% of seafood consumed in the U.S. is imported. 2% of that is inspected by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration..



## U.S., Vietnam team up for food safety

The High Quality Việt Nam Products Business Association, the American Chamber of Commerce in Việt Nam and the Washington-based Global Food Safety Forum signed a memorandum of understanding on co-operation in food safety. The US imports 15% of its food, 20% of vegetables, 50% of fruit and 80% of seafood, according to the U.S. FDA, which has established an International Food Safety Capacity Building Plan to train foreign governments and food producers on U.S. requirements for food safety.



## ExxonMobile-PetroVietnam sign Ca Voi Xanh natural gas deal

ExxonMobil signed two agreements January 13 relating to the Ca Voi Xanh (Blue Whale) gas project offshore Vietnam. The project could fuel at least four power plants shortly after scheduled first gas in 2023. "The Ca Voi Xanh field is located about 80 km offshore central Vietnam and is an important natural gas discovery in Vietnam that has the potential to fuel the country's economic growth." PVEP said the project could supply enough gas for power plants with total capacity of 3 GW and also allow expansion for the petrochemical or power sectors. It said total investment in the project chain could be \$10bn, contributing \$20bn to state coffers.



## SCS [Bien Dong] Reserves and Resources - U.S. EIA

Energy Information Administration estimates the South China Sea contains approximately 11 billion barrels of oil and 190 trillion cubic feet of natural gas in proved and probable reserves. Conventional hydrocarbons mostly reside in undisputed territory. Undiscovered resources could be greater. In November 2012, the Chinese National Offshore Oil Company (CNOOC) estimated the area holds around 125 billion barrels of oil and 500 trillion cubic feet of natural gas in undiscovered resources, although independent studies have not confirmed this figure.



## Vietnam to apply extensive area code changes in 2017

Area code changes in Ho Chi Minh City, Hanoi, Dong Nai, Binh Duong, and a number of other provinces will take place on June 17, 2017. The new area codes will be applied for 59 cities and provinces in three phases, from February 11 to June 17, with steps taken to ensure the change will not confuse the public, the Ministry of Information and Communications announced. But there are other concerns, such as the need to reprint packaging or business cards once numbers are changed, costing quite a sum.
