Minimum wage to increase 6.5

The regional minimum wage for 2018 is expected to increase by 6.5 per cent, equal to VND180,000-230,000 (US\$8-10) a month, believed to be the lowest increase ever.

The increase was announced on Monday after the National Wage Council concluded its third discussion on the regional minimum wage for 2018, with a consensus reached between employer and labour representatives.



Tuna export revenue surges 21%

Vietnam's tuna export turnover has risen 21 per cent year-on-year to hit US\$271 million in the first half of 2017.

Sharing export details, the Vietnam Association of Seafood Exporters and Producers (VASEP) said that tuna fillet brought in the most revenue, accounting for around 48 per cent of total tuna exports, followed by canned tuna (30 per cent) and other processed tuna (15 per cent).



Vietnam catfish exporters worry as US applies tougher inspection procedures from Aug 2

Vietnamese catfish exporters are concerned that the door for their products to enter the U.S. will be narrowed after a new inspection rule takes effect next month.

From August 2, all Vietnamese catfish shipments to the U.S. must be transferred to official import inspection establishments specified by the U.S. Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) for re-inspection before they can be forwarded to importers and sold to American end-consumers.



United States littoral combat ship visits Vietnam

A United States Navy littoral combat ship has docked at an international seaport in the south-central Vietnamese province of Khanh Hoa, commencing a series of exchanges between the two nations' naval forces

The Independence-class vessel USS Coronado (LCS-4) arrived at the Cam Ranh International Port, located in the namesake city in Khanh Hoa, on Wednesday morning.

Captained by Alexis T. Walker, commander of the Destroyer Squadron 7, the ship and its crew of 130 naval officers are scheduled to visit Vietnam from July 6 to 11.




Dong Thap Province calling for Investment

Why the U.S. imports tainted food that can kill you: The Hill

This week the CDC reported that at least 47 people were stricken with Salmonella, with one death, likely linked to papayas imported from Mexico. In the summer of 2016 came reports of hepatitis A tainted scallops sickening 292 in Hawaii. In that outbreak two died of liver failure complications. And, also in 2016, 143 people, mostly in Virginia, were also stricken with hepatitis A. This time the culprit was hepatitis A-tainted strawberries imported from Egypt.



Vietnam's growing demand for US property

Vietnamese people's demand for foreign property, especially in the US, has been increasing in recent years. Experts say this increase can be attributed to Vietnam's fast growing economy and Vietnamese people's belief that the US is a good place to live and work.

A report by the US National Association of Realtors (NAR) showed that between April 2016 and March 2017, Vietnamese buyers purchased approximately 5,689 residential properties in the US, roughly double of the previous 12-months period.

US-based casino operator and hospitality business Hard Rock International Inc. has confirmed its interest in developing a casino at Laguna Lang Co integrated resort complex in the central province of Thua Thien-Hue, according to newswire GGRAsia.

A new decree will help improve the quality of corporate governance in public companies and benefit small, individual investors, a senior official said yesterday.

Corporate governance has become an urgent issue for public companies as it affects a firm's sustainability when its size and scale develops at a fast speed, Pham Hong Son, vice chairman of the State Securities Commission (SSC), said at a conference.



Export revenue likely to hit US\$200 billion in 2017

Vietnam is likely to reach total export turnover of US\$200 billion for 2017, increasing more than 13 per cent from last year and exceeding the set target, deputy minister of Industry and Trade Do Thang Hai daimed at a meeting in Ha Noi yesterday.



Apple wants to change the way doctors and patients talk to each other - by giving everyone an iPad

Awad Lsallum has been waiting for a heart for 40 days at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles. One of the worst parts of a long hospital stay, he said, can be not having a clear picture of what your situation is, or even who is taking care of you as the days drag on.

But now, at least at Cedars-Sinai, there's an app for all of that. Actually, there's a whole tablet. The hospital is offering some patients the option to check out iPads during their stay for free, to provide more insight into their health. The program offers a glimpse of how Apple is trying to further tap into

the \$3 trillion health-care market.



First Energy Efficiency Network launched in Vietnam

Vietnam's first Energy Efficiency Network has been officially launched in Ho Chi Minh City, giving a platform for companies to connect and improve energy efficiency.



US First Solar resumes long-delayed \$1.2 billion project

After years of failing looking for suitable investors to take its place and carry out the \$1.2-billion project in Ho Chi Minh City, First Solar (US) has decided to resume the solar panel manufacturing project.

Late last year, in a conference call with investors and industry analysts to discuss the firm's 2017 operations, chief executive officer Mark Widmar revealed that they could even look to use the plant in Vietnam that was built but has not yet put into operation.



Tropical Storm Talas approaches Vietnam

Ha Noi ... probability for Tropical Storm is 40% in about 24 hours. The storm track is usually updated every 12 hours at 7am and 7pm VNTime. Note that storm tracks can and do change frequently.



Full enforcement of USDA inspection of Siluriformes fish, including catfish will begin on Aug 2

USDA's Food Safety and inspection Service's plans to reinspect all shipments of imported Siluriformes fish and fish products, including catfish, beginning on Aug. 2, one month earlier than originally scheduled, according to a Federal Register Notice published on July 3. Countries that want to continue to export siluriformes fish and fish products, including catfish, to the U.S. must submit a complete "Self-Reporting Tool" and supporting documentation to USDA/FSIS by Sep 1, 2017.
