
Vietnam an FDI magnet in Southeast Asia: experts

Vietnam is among the few ASEAN member countries to consistently improve its attractiveness to foreign investors due to its growing economy and improving business climate, according to experts.



Start-ups embrace logistics sector

In a report on the Vietnamese logistics market released by the business data and information provider StoxPlus, the percentage of logistics cost over the nation's total gross domestic product (GDP) is 20.8 per cent, much higher than the world's average rate of 10-11 per cent.



Vietnam among 10 fastest-growing economies

In the report, ICAEW predicts that economic growth across Southeast Asia (SEA) is expected to slow down in 2019 to 5 percent, after an estimated 5.3 percent in 2018. It attributed the slowdown to US-China tensions.



Justice Dept. combats economic espionage by China

Washington, DC. Nov 1, 2018. The Justice Department unveiled a broad new initiative to combat what it says is mounting criminal economic activity by China, announcing the plan as U.S. officials unsealed charges against several individuals and Chinese and Taiwanese companies for trade-secret theft.

The Justice department announced charges against economic espionage on behalf of the Chinese government in the fields of semiconductors (theft from Micron Technology), commercial jet aircraft engines (GE Aviation).



US strikes at heart of 'Made in China' with Huawei arrest

BEIJING/WASHINGTON - Dec 7, 2018. The arrest in Canada of Meng Wanzhou, chief financial officer of Chinese telecommunications equipment maker Huawei Technologies, on the very day that the presidents of the U.S. and China dined together augurs rough seas ahead for the Sino-American trade talks.

The arrest disrupts the conciliatory mood thought to have been created last week at the dinner between U.S. President Donald Trump and Chinese President Xi Jinping. High-tech has immediately been thrust to the forefront of the 90-day trade negotiations.



Taiwanese iPhone assembler leaves China for Indonesia/Singapore

TAIPEI - Key iPhone assembler Pegatron has chosen Indonesia/Singapore for its first diversification of manufacturing away from China in the wake of costly trade tensions between Washington and Beijing.

The Taiwan-based electronics manufacturer is preparing to shift production of non-iPhone products hit by U.S. tariffs on Chinese exports to a rented factory on Indonesia's Batam Island within the next six months.



Taiwanese firms leaving China

That was the message from Prime Minister Nguyen Xuan Phuc at the opening ceremony of the national start-up day 'Techfest 2018' in the central city on Thursday.

He stressed that start-up programmes will help the country reach its target of each person earning US\$18,000 per year by 2045 when Vietnam celebrates the 100th anniversary of the Independence.

U.S. Advance rulings are legally binding written decisions by U.S. Customs and Border Protection at the request of the person concerned on specific particulars, classification, origin, origin markings, valuation, etc., in relation to the intended importation of goods into the United States.
