

Draft of the Labor Code (amended) is currently revised and finalized by the Ministry of Labour - Invalids and Social Affairs to submit to the Government for the first time in April 2019. This is a Code with a vast scope of adjustment and a profound effect on the business environment in Vietnam as well as Vietnam's economic integration process to the world.
