# **Executive Director Update**

Vietnam continues to receive global recognition for its effective management of the COVID-19 pandemic- now over 70 days without community spread! And Vietnam's most critically ill patient is now fully conscious, able to stand with help, and doctors expect will be able to walk normally in a couple of weeks. We hope you are now getting your regular healthcare checks, as well as getting out and supporting your local restaurants, and local shops, enjoying a staycation at a nearby hotel -- or visiting some of the other beautiful resorts and destinations in Vietnam! Crowds are returning to airports and tourist destinations, so remember your masks and take appropriate safety precautions. I now travel everywhere with hand sanitizer, antibacterial wipes, and a small bottle of alcohol (not the drinking kind:). And, as many of you have noticed, try to avoid shaking hands. A summary of recent actions is below:

**1. Policy Recommendations.** AmCham Vietnam-HCMC continues to make an impact. Thanks to your feedback and recommendations, and expert advisers in our COVID19 Policy Task Force (Baker & McKenzie's Fred Burke, Nguyen Thuy Hang, Chung Yee, and Nguyen Thanh Vinh; AIM's Mark Gillin; Mayer Brown's Ursula Szotyory-Grove; and Vriens & Co's Sam Pursch) - as well as often Chair of AmCham Hanoi VBF and Legal Committee Nguyen Thanh Hai, we are providing timely, constructive recommendations to the Vietnamese government on both COVID-related and general trade and investment policies. This week, we also will share some recommendations with the Ministry of Planning and Investment to improve the business environment.

2. Contributions of Goods and Financial Contributions by AmCham and our Member Companies to Support the Vietnamese Government's Response. AmCham Vietnam-HCMC commends the effectiveness of actions taken by Vietnamese Government leaders in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and is proud of the contributions toward this response made by our member companies. We are delighted to see Vietnam's response finally getting global recognition.

We are now working with Vietnam Fatherland Front and HCMC Center for Disease Control (HCDC) to schedule the Delivery Ceremony of a Realtime PCR analyzer in the 2nd week of July to donate to the HCDC in managing its response to COVID-19 and other infectious diseases. We very much appreciate the generous contributions from First Solar, Diag Labs, MSD, Cargill, Russin & Vecchi, and UPC Renewables.

# Some additional tips below from Dr. Mason Cobb, Vice-Chair, and Dr. Andy Meadows, of AmCham Healthcare Committee's Medical Providers Subcommittee:

The global battle against the COVID-19 pandemic rages on with some regions and countries showing little sign of progress, and others displaying signs of a second wave. The situation remains calm in Vietnam, now 10 weeks without domestic community transmission. A successful response in any infectious disease outbreak requires the Public Health and Healthcare systems to integrate and collaborate. A strong response is required from both.

In the United States, at least 465 front-line healthcare workers lost their lives due to COVID-19 as of this week, more than the 412 first responders who lost their lives in the 9/11 terrorist attacks. Another 84,000 have tested positive for the disease. These are likely only a fraction of the total, as employment type is not recorded in all cases. And the pandemic in the United States is continuing with several states' healthcare facilities over-stressed. So, the numbers of healthcare workers affected is likely to increase, with perhaps more deaths. These numbers demonstrate the ever-present risk of healthcare workers sacrificing themselves to serve those among us who become ill.

No deaths have occurred in Vietnam among healthcare workers or military personnel in quarantine camps, but a cluster of

fortunate and extremely effective.

Of course, the list of essential front-line workers goes beyond just those associated with the delivery of healthcare, directly or indirectly. Supermarket and convenience store clerks, city services employees, public safety officers, cleaners, caretakers, delivery drivers – anyone who kept serving people so the rest of us could stay home. The risks braved by these workers helped us all manage the lockdown and social distancing period more safely, successfully, and comfortably.

As life in Vietnam returns increasingly to normal and these sacrifices become less directly obvious, take a moment to remember and appreciate those who risked their health and lives for us. We salute them!
